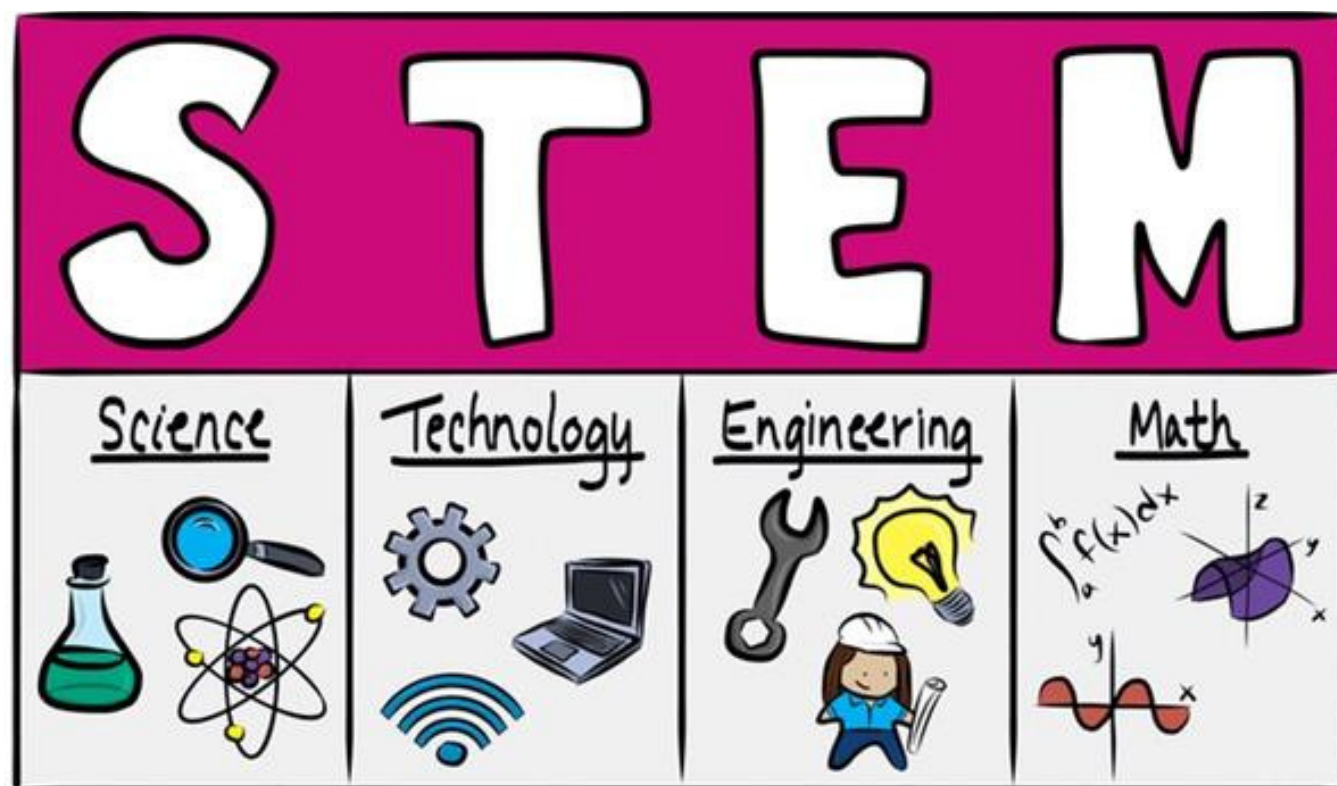

THREE VILLAGE STEM SUMMER CAMPS

AUGUST 1-5 AT WARD MELVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

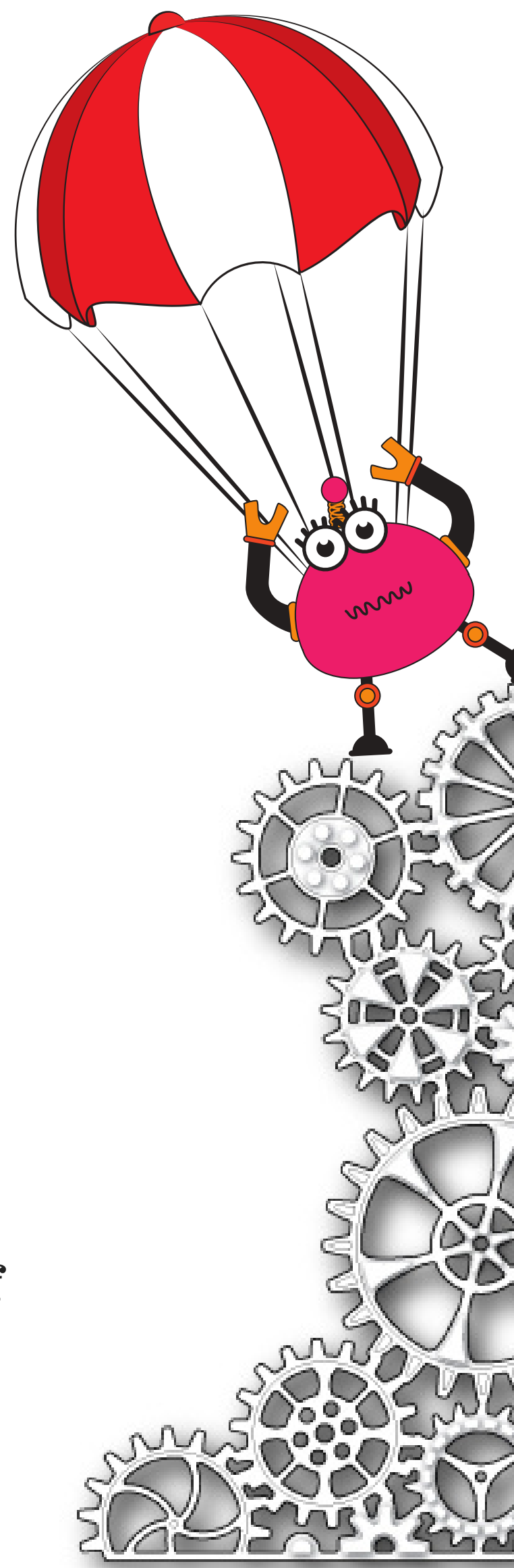


The Three Village STEM Enrichment Foundation in conjunction with the Three Village School District will be offering STEM summer camps in August at Ward Melville High School. The program will be for grades 1-12 and will include classes that promote enrichment in science, technology, engineering and math.

Classes will meet for 3 hours each day from 9:00-12:00. Registration forms and fees must be mailed in during the registration period of March 1- April 30. Enrollment is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis.

All money raised from the camps will be used to support STEM activities in our community. Tuition for each 5-day class is \$340 for district residents, \$350 for non-residents. Please submit a separate check for each class. All tuition and fees are nonrefundable, unless a class is canceled due to insufficient registration. Assume your child has been granted his/her choice unless you are contacted.

Parents are requested to escort their children to their class and pick them up after the class. You may be asked to show identification when picking up your child. Please note that only parents or an authorized designee can pick up children. Parents are not permitted to remain in the room during classes. Camp Schedule and Descriptions

August 1-5, 2022 9:00-12:00

KEVA Planks Camp (Grades 1-3)

KEVA planks have captured the imagination of companies and organizations such as Mensa, DreamWorks, Maker Faire, Destination Imagination and many other museums, schools and families across the country. The 1st-3rd graders in our community will now have the opportunity to participate in a KEVA Planks camp. Research has shown that when children use KEVA planks "attention spans lengthen, concentration deepens, teamwork happens, excitement builds, and children learn" (Mindware, 2018). In this camp, students will complete challenges and tasks independently and in teams. If you have a builder and dreamer, this is the camp for them.

Makerspace Camp (Grades 1-3)

Creativity is one of the most important life skills. In this camp, students will have the opportunity to use their creativity to design, explore, make, and share their ideas. Students will use blocks, cardboard, marbles, string, spaghetti, bananas, and even marshmallows to create a variety of hi-tech and low tech projects. \$15

Volcanoes and Natural Disasters Camp (Grades 4-7)

Come brave the storm in this wild natural disasters camp. We will learn about tornados, volcanoes, tsunamis, hurricanes and other natural disasters. Join us in creating explosive volcanoes, building strong structures to withstand earthquakes, and simulating tsunamis and other natural disasters in order to learn how these natural disasters impact our ecosystem. Materials fee: \$20

Young Engineers Camp (Grades 4-7)

This camp is designed to spark enthusiasm in engineering. Activities during this week will include everything from balloon cars and bottle rockets to roller coasters and spaghetti towers. A variety of hands-on design challenges will encourage students to develop curiosity, as well as problem solving and teamwork skills. Materials fee: \$20

Architecture and Interior Design Camp (Grades 4-9)

This camp is for students who love to watch home design shows and enjoy rearranging their rooms. In this introductory class, students will learn about the interior and architectural design fields. The class will provide hands-on learning opportunities from designing your own tiny home to understanding colors, textures, and styles. Students bring designs to life by developing a mini portfolio. On the last day, students will be able to share their designs at an open house event (similar to how a designer would present to a client). \$20

Junior Paleontology Camp (Grades 4-9)

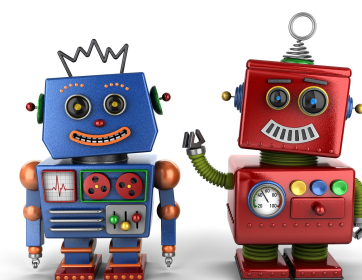
This camp is for students interested in paleontology, archaeology, and geology. Campers will learn to identify and prepare fossils, rocks and minerals in real and replica specimens. The camp will include how paleontologist and geologist use critical thinking and the scientific method to understand the world of earth and biological sciences.

CSI/Forensics Camp (Grades 5-9)

Come spend the week taking a deep dive into crime scene investigation! Together we will learn to collect, analyze and process the evidence that could be used to crack a case. We will be taking a look at what is done in the forensics lab in order to solve mysteries and predict which suspects were responsible for a crime. Materials Fee \$20

3-D Printer Camp (Grades 5-12)

Here is your opportunity to get involved with 3-D printing. In this camp, students will build a 3-D printer and learn how to design and print with it. Students will have the option to purchase their printer and take it home. Students who do not want to purchase a printer will be paired with other students to build. The camp will build the PRUSA Mini. The materials fee will be due at registration. It will cover the cost of the 3-D printer and supplies. Material Fee: \$425
