Re: Grade 7 Course Verification Process

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Welcome to R.C. Murphy Junior High School! Due to the demanding nature of the seventh grade academic curriculum, careful placement in seventh grade courses is especially important. Our goal is to provide students with stimulating and challenging coursework and to place students in a program of study where they can enjoy a positive and successful learning experience.

The courses in which your child will be enrolled at the start of the seventh grade school year will be posted on the parent portal on **Monday, May 6th at 9 a.m.** Your child's course registration can be found on the Parent Portal on the left side under "More >Course Registration."

The following criteria are used as a guideline for consideration to appropriately place students into the honors programs for English, Social Studies, Science and Math:

- Report Card
- AIMSweb Reading Assessment
- i-Ready Math Assessment

It is important to note that the above criteria serve only as a guideline for placement decisions and does not guarantee placement into honors courses. All placement decisions are carefully reviewed in an effort to maintain the integrity of our program and offer students the most appropriate educational program of study. In the event that you believe your child qualifies for placement in a course at a different level, you may appeal the indicated placement.

In order to make a placement appeal, please submit an email to murphyappeals@3villagescd.org with the following information by Wednesday, June 12th :

- State the reason(s) you believe your child's placement should be changed and any additional information, which you believe, is pertinent to a change in placement in seventh grade courses.
- We will also consider report cards from previous years.

Each appeal will be carefully reviewed by building administration and department chairs, and parents will receive an email notification of the school's decision by **Wednesday, June 26th**. We trust this process will serve to resolve


Should you wish to change your child's **elective course(s) only**, please email **the Murphy Guidance Office at mursched@3villagescd.org by Wednesday, June 12th.**

Junior High School student schedules, which include courses, assigned teachers, class periods, and room numbers, will be posted on the portal on or about **Friday August 16th**.


