CALL TO ORDER Mr. Diviney called the meeting open at 6:09 pm.

MOVE INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION Mr. Kornreich motioned to move into Executive Session at 6:10 pm in accordance with Open Meeting Law §105 (e) collective negotiations pursuant to article fourteen of the civil service law (Nurses, Substitute Teachers, Child Care, Food Service Workers, Security, PERB Action); (f) the employment history of a particular person (M & O); Exempt items under FERPA (Superintendent Hearing Appeals), seconded by Mr. McIntosh, and carried by a 5-0-0 vote.
