2011-2012 BUDGET

Program Reduction Review The Board continued its review of the proposed budget reductions presented by the Administration.

Discussion ensued regarding Level 1 (first round of reductions), Level 2 (next areas for possible reductions), and Contingency reductions (those reductions recommended if the District needs to operate under a contingency budget). A consensus was reached to review the proposed reductions line by line to close the \$6.95 million budget deficit.

Some adjustments were made moving reductions from Level 2 to Level 1. The Board will continue its line by line review at the next Budget Meeting on March 29, 2011.
