2012-2013 BUDGET SUMMATION AND REVIEW Mr. Carlson presented the 2012-2013 Budget Summation and Review.

Proposed 2012-2013 Recommended Budget and Property Tax Report Card Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, be it RESOLVED that a budget in the amount of \$178,608,110 be adopted for the 2012-2013 school year.
