BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in implementing such opinion and award, pursuant to Section 913 of the New York State Education Law, the Board of Education directs said employee to appear for a medical examination in the office of Dr. Randall Solomon at a date and time to be scheduled; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in implementing such opinion and award, said employee shall be suspended without pay until such time that the employee reports for said Section 913 examination and complies with the directives of the psychiatrist and Board of Education.

On motion by Mr. Connors, seconded by Mrs. Gische, and carried by a 5-0-0 vote, the Board approved the resolution as presented.
